Intertek Testing Services (ETL) notifies consumers, retailers and distributors that the following Wi-Fi Infrared Heater bears unauthorized ETL<sub>US</sub> and cETL<sub>US</sub> Certification Mark. 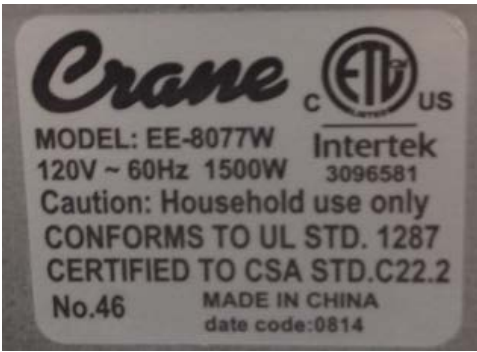
