Intertek Warns of Invalid ETL Certification Mark on Retro Popcorn Maker

The following is a notification from Intertek that the Retro Popcorn maker identified below bears invalid Intertek Certification Marks for Canada. The products have been evaluated by Intertek. However, the configuration with an ungrounded attachment cord and plug (2 prong) is not suitable for use in Canada.
